Information and registration

The BASF Tennis Club offers the option to use the fitness area in Hall 2 in addition to its tennis and padel memberships. The fee is €60/year for "Active First Membership" and "Youth Membership" and €120/year for all other membership types (in addition to the membership fee). Cancellations must be submitted in writing by September 30 of the current year and will take effect on December 31. Late cancellations will take effect on December 31 of the following year.

Terms of use

Please review the terms of use for the fitness area in Hall 2. By signing, users agree to comply with all listed points. The BASF Tennis Club e.V. reserves the right to revoke access to the fitness area in cases of serious violations of the terms of use. In such cases, the already paid fee will not be refunded.

1. Access permission / User ID card

The fitness area is accessible from Monday to Sunday during the designated hours (Monday to Friday: 9:00 AM - 9:00 PM, Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 AM - 6:00 PM) exclusively for members of the BASF Tennis Club e.V. who have additionally booked the fitness area option. The minimum age for access and usage permission is 16 years. For minors, a prior written consent from their parents is required. Each user will receive a user ID card as a PDF file via email upon completion of the additional „Fitness Area“ option. This serves as access authorization and must be presented upon request by the club, with a digital proof, such as on a smartphone. If the user ID card cannot be presented upon request, the club reserves the right to ask the user to leave the fitness area immediately. The access authorization is personal and non-transferable to third parties without the club's consent.

2. Payment

The fee for the use of the fitness area is debited annually by the club. For this purpose, the club uses the completed and signed direct debit mandate provided as part of the membership agreement. Offsetting against the usage fee or exercising a right of retention is only permitted in cases of undisputed or legally established counterclaims.

3. Terms of use / liability

The use of the fitness area is the sole responsibility of the member of the BASF Tennis Club e.V. without supervision by the club or the provision of a trainer. For this reason, the club cannot maintain constant operational safety. The fitness equipment is inspected annually for safety by a professional company. Any identified defects will be rectified by the club as quickly as possible.

Users are required to inform themselves about the proper use of the equipment. Club-organized fitness courses take priority in the use of training equipment; during such times, access to the fitness area may be limited. The club and the user agree that the entire fitness area is a self-check-in zone. Before using the facilities and fitness equipment, the user must inspect them for any potential safety defects, regardless of the annual safety checks performed by a professional company. Defects or risks may arise, for example, if prior users have left the facilities or equipment improperly used or unsecured. When training with weights, the weight plates must be secured with clamps on the bars. Safety distances must be observed, and users must ensure that no other person is endangered. Users are solely responsible for assessing their physical and mental ability to use the fitness area independently and safely. The club accepts no liability for the loss or damage of clothing, valuables or money brought by users unless the loss or damage is due to gross negligence or willful misconduct by the club, its representatives, or agents. Liability for simple negligence by the club is excluded, except in cases of injury to life, body, health or the violation of essential contractual obligations due to negligence by the club, its representatives, or agents. Essential contractual obligations are those whose fulfillment is necessary for the proper execution of the agreement and on whose compliance the member regularly relies. Users are liable for improper use and/or damage caused by excessive use of the facilities or fitness equipment. Any damage must be reported to the club immediately.

4. Extended house rules

The user agrees to handle the fitness area and fitness equipment with care and to respect the rights of other users. The fitness area must not be entered with street shoes. Fitness equipment may only be used within the scope of its designated purpose. If the user has no experience with sports equipment, particularly strength training machines, an introduction by the club, its board, or its agents is required. Fitness equipment and the areas used must be cleaned after use. A towel must be placed on the weight bench during use.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages, intoxicating substances, or performance-enhancing drugs is prohibited in the fitness area. It is not permitted to grant access to the fitness area to third parties who do not have access authorization. The club, its legal representatives, and its agents are authorized to issue instructions necessary for maintaining the orderly operation of the fitness area, ensuring order and safety, or enforcing compliance with the house rules. These instructions must be followed.

5. Final Provisions

Should individual provisions of these terms of use be ineffective or prove unenforceable, this shall not entitle either party to assert claims for damages. This does not automatically render the terms of use invalid. Ineffective or unenforceable provisions of these terms of use shall be replaced by a provision through supplementary interpretation that comes as close as possible to the intended contractual regulation. In the event that no such provision can be established, the law shall apply as a substitute for the ineffective or unenforceable provision.

INFORMATION ON DATA PROTECTION

As part of the membership acquisition at BASF Tennisclub e.V., personal data will be collected from you. The collection of personal data is required for the administration of the membership, booking courts, participation in activities of the affiliated tennis school, participation in tournaments and other events. According to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the data controller is required to provide the information mentioned in the articles to the affected individual at the time of data collection. The following data is processed for the administration of the membership (e.g., invitations to meetings, contribution collection, billing, organization of sports activities, locker rental, volunteer work, contact for questions and issues), court booking, participation in activities of the affiliated tennis school (e.g., organization of training activities, billing, contact for questions and issues), participation in competition, tournament, and game operations, and participation in events (e.g., organization of events, billing, contact for questions and issues): first name, last name, street, house number, postal code, city, phone number, email address, date of birth, nationality, gender, membership category, club/employer (only for company sports membership), place/date/signature of the membership application, date/duration/court of the court booking, and first name/last name/street/house number/postal code/city/IBAN/BIC/SEPA mandate reference/place/date/signature of the payer.

The data is processed based on the necessity for the performance of a contract according to Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR. The data is shared with the affiliated tennis school, TennisBase Steffen Neutert, and Brandstätter & Co. KG (software: tennis04 for court booking and membership management). The following data is shared with VR Bank Rhein Neckar eG for contribution collection: first name, last name, IBAN, BIC, name of the bank, SEPA mandate reference, date of signature of the payer. The following data is shared with nu Datenautomaten GmbH (software: nuLiga) for participation in competition, tournament, and game operations: first name, last name, date of birth, nationality, gender. The data will be stored for the duration of the membership. Upon termination of the membership, the data will be deleted or retained for an additional ten years in accordance with legal retention periods and then deleted. Between the termination of the membership and the deletion of the data, the processing of the data will be restricted.

The following data will be published in connection with sports events, including reports on the BASF Tennisclub e.V. website and affiliated tennis school, in print media of BASF Tennisclub e.V., on BASF Tennisclub e.V.'s social media appearances (e.g., Facebook, Instagram, BASF Tennisclub app), and shared with local, regional, and national print media: first name, last name, year of birth, nationality, gender, performance class, team affiliation, results and images. The processing of this data is based on consent according to Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR. The consent is voluntary and not linked to membership. For individuals under 16 years old, additional consent from a legal guardian is required. The personal data will be stored until the consent is withdrawn. The consent may be revoked with future effect via email to mail@lu-tennis.de. The revocation of consent does not affect the legality of the processing that occurred based on the consent before the revocation.

The following data will be processed for sending the newsletter: email address, time of registration (date and time), and time of unsubscription (date and time). This data is processed by rapidmail GmbH based on consent according to Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR. rapidmail GmbH is prohibited from using the data for purposes other than sending the newsletter. Data sharing or selling is not permitted. Rapidmail is a certified German newsletter software provider carefully selected in compliance with the requirements of the GDPR and the Federal Data Protection Act. The consent is voluntary and not linked to membership. For individuals under 16 years old, additional consent from a legal guardian is required. The personal data will be stored until the unsubscription. Consent can be revoked with future effect via the unsubscribe link in the newsletter. The revocation of consent does not affect the legality of the processing that occurred based on the consent before the revocation.
